Dear Parent/Carer

Timetable arrangements for Year 11 from Monday 13 June 2016

As you will be aware your son/daughter is in the middle of the GCSE examinations, working hard in school to access as much time and support as possible in order to do his/her very best.

It has been a genuine pleasure to see Year 11 working in intervention classes in the subjects that are a priority for them, be it getting extra practise with English, mathematics and science, or completing their ECDL qualification, or doing extra work for a subject where they still have an examination.

I am sure you are as proud of your son/daughter as we are. Outwood Academy Carlton has an impressive culture of learning, in part down to the hard work, focus and commitment that Year 11 (and Year 10) are showing to younger students during a challenging examination season.

I write to give you a brief overview of how your son/daughter's timetable will look from Monday 13 June. Each student also has a personalised timetable showing remaining exams, intervention classes and when to attend.

Mon 13 June Y11 attend all day in science intervention classes, ECDL or private study

Tues 14 June Y11 follow intervention timetables. Students who have completed ECDL will be able to be at home if not in intervention classes. Students who have completed ECDL will have a letter to inform parents that this is the case.

Wed 15 June Y11 attend all day: **afternoon Chemistry GCSE Exam.** Please note: **Triple Science students will not complete their exam until 3.30pm**

Thur 16 June Y11 follow intervention timetables. Students who have completed ECDL will be able to be at home if not in intervention classes.

Fri 17 June Y11 in for **morning Physics GCSE Exam** then follow intervention timetables. Students who have completed ECDL will be able to be at home if not in intervention classes in geography, statistics or further maths. There is an **afternoon Geography GCSE Exam**

Mon 20 June Y11 follow intervention timetables. Students who have completed ECDL will be able to be at home if not in intervention classes in statistics or further maths.

Tues 21 June Y11 follow intervention timetables. Students who have completed ECDL will be able to be at home if not in intervention classes in statistics or further maths.

Wed 22 June Y11 follow intervention timetables in the morning and leave at 10.25am to allow time to prepare for PROM.

Thur 23 June Year 11 are invited to PROM breakfast at 10.45am to formally say goodbye. All students are asked to attend this.

Fri 24 June Y11 follow intervention timetables. Students who have completed ECDL will be able to be at home if not in intervention classes. **Morning Further Maths GCSE Exam.**

Mon 27 June **Morning Statistics GCSE Exam.**

Please note that students must follow their intervention timetables which highlight their personalised intervention classes, attend all examinations and if they have not yet completed ECDL, need to continue to attend until they have gained this qualification.
