Pupil Premium Eligibility

Dear Parents/ Carers,

I wanted to take the time to write to every family about eligibility for Pupil Premium funding for schools and academies. Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding. By applying for Free School Meals (whether your child decides to have them or not), the academy will receive **£1,320 per year additional** funding in the form of Pupil Premium. This is an invaluable source of income for schools in times when budgets have been drastically reduced.

Additional funding last year meant that we could employ additional adults to support student's learning and social/emotional needs and buy resources to help support students' learning. This year, this funding is going further to support additional support sessions in the academy such as iSpace and our improved Careers provision. Further details of how this funding is used is published annually on the academy website. To check your eligibility and apply for free school meals you should visit

Alternatively, please pop into the academy and a member of our team can support you with checking eligibility and making an application.

If you are in receipt of one of the following benefits, please apply online, by telephone or by calling into the academy in person for support:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
