Dear Parent/Carer,

Outwood Academy Carlton recently launched a Home Learning programme called Sparx Reader. This programme is aimed at developing your child's literacy levels and to try and foster, or enhance, a love of reading amongst students that they can take with them into adulthood.

In order to accommodate this programme further, an after school reading club will be running in the Library on Wednesdays from 2:30pm until 3:30pm. This club is not compulsory; it is intended to help students complete their reading should they encounter problems at home that may hinder their ability to engage with, and complete, their reading. It will also provide students a reading space where there is a dedicated member of staff who might be able to help them understand and enjoy their reading further.

If your child would like to attend the after school Sparx reading club, they will need to present their planner to a member of staff in the library so their barcode can be scanned and their attendance can be logged. They will be allowed to stay in the Library until they have completed their reading or until the end of the session.
